In forwarding the dead body of one HETAL PAREKH, H/F, 18 years with permission of her the Director of Health Services, Govt. of West Bengal for P.M. Examination by you, I would like to state the brief fact of the case. On 5.3.90 at about 18.05 hrs. the victim girl was found lying dead inside her 3rd floor flat at 57A and B Padoapukur Road while she was alone and it is suspected that she was murdered and she was raped also before murder. Blood was found on the floor where she was lying on back and blood stains were found on her face and head/hair. The investigation revealed that she was alone inside the flat between 17.20 hrs. and 18.05 hrs.

This case appears to be a case of rape and murder.

I would request you to hold the P.M. examination over the dead body and to opine on the following points:-

- A) Cause of death and the details of injuries if any.
- B) If injuries are found whether it would have been done by one or more.
- C) Time of death.
- D) Whether the victim was raped.
- E) Any marks of violence in case of resistance by the victim.
- F) Opinion on any other points of medico-legal importance.

The following articles are to be preserved.

- 1) Viscera, blood, Central hair and nail scrap, wearing

wearing apparels etc.

- 2) Any foreign article if found.
- 3) Any other thing of medico-legal importance.

After the P.M. Exam. the dead body may be made over to Sri Nagardas Parakh, the father of the victim girl C/MLT/36 Arun Kr. Saha, will identify the dead body.

I am furnishing herewith answer to the queries ~~posed~~
posed by the I.O. of the above case in connection with the
Post-mortem examination of the above case.

Q. A. Cause of death and the details of injuries, if any.

Ans. Please see the Post-mortem report No. 232 dated 6.3.90
of Calcutta Police Morgue.

Q. B. If injuries are found, whether it could have been done by
one or more.

Ans. The injuries found on the body of the deceased could have
been caused by the act of one person.

Q. C. Time of death.

Ans. Excluding the period of preservation inside cooling
chamber, if any, about 6-18 hours before conduction of
Post-mortem examination.

Q. D. Whether the victim was raped?

Ans. The finding in the hymen and matted pubic hair indicates
that she was subjected to sexual intercourse. Vaginal
swab and matted pubic hair has been preserved.

Q. E. Any marks of violence in case of resistance by the
victim.

Ans. Injuries No. 14, 15, 16 & 17 mentioned in the Post-mortem
report (Over upper arm of left side, elbow and hip) and
injuries over the face strongly suggest that the victim
offered resistance.

Q. F. Opinion on any other points of medico-legal importance.

Ans. The injuries over the face indicate that her face was pressed against some hard substance.
